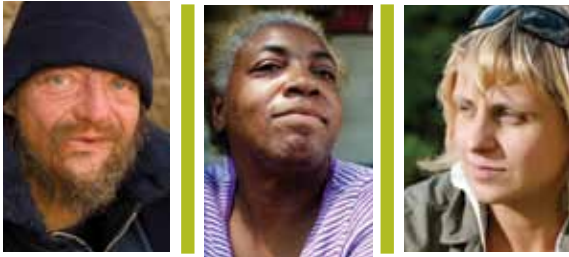

West Salem Foursquare Church (WSFC) and Salem Alliance Church (SAC) are partnering to expand the Salem Free Medical Clinic. The clinic was started five years ago by WSFC and it has operated two afternoons a month at Walker Middle School gym. As SAC began praying about God's plan for its new Broadway building, a medical clinic rose to the top. At the same time, SFMC was praying for a permanent place to call home. Because we serve a great God who knows all things, He led us to a church partnership.

We will move into our permanent location on Broadway in September

2010. Until then, God has generously provided a rental space at 3850 Portland Rd NE. We are eager to bring hope and health to as many people as possible.

"Over the last year, free clinics have seen patient load increase by 40-50%," said Nicole D. Lamoureux, Executive Director of the National Association of Free Clinics. "People who just last year had health insurance are now out of work and need to have their health care needs met."

"We felt like we were teetering on the edge of a cliff with all the other bills

we had to pay, and if we had to pay those hospital bills too, that would have tipped us over," said a patient.

"All the people who work in the clinic are incredibly good because they always do whatever is necessary to help the patients feel better, be healthy and be happy."
